# SeaCycler



SeaCycler is made from 99% recycled PET plastic and is powered by an electric motor.

SeaCycler weighs 1 ton and 8,000 plastic bottles were used in her construction.

SeaCycler is one of only 6 boats of its kind in the world!

SeaCycler is a 10-seater plaswood punt built by Mark Edwards MBE, who also made the Royal Barge Gloriana.

SeaCycler skippers are RYA qualified and brimming with local knowledge and enthusiasm.

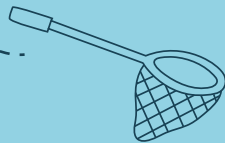
